Spelling Patterns/Rules
<u>Vowel Pair ee</u> - The (e) sound in initial, medial, or final position of a one-syllable base word is spelled "ee" as in feet.
<u>short e</u> - The (e) sound in initial or medial position is spelled "e" as in echo.
* Do not use SOS method for irregular words. Irregular words must be memorized.
